












Generating new ideas

- 7. Rearrange aspects of the object
- reorganize the basic layout
- e.g menu bars on bottom, pop-up scrollbars...

8. Change the point of view

- imagine seeing/presenting the information from a different perspective
- e.g. view desktop from high above-> overviews!

9. Combine the data into an ensemble

- what larger metaphor might the object be part of?
- e.g. desktop -> room -> building->city
 - different rooms for different tasks
 - communications metaphors between rooms and buildings...
